SUBJECT: New Letter for Child Status Screen

DISCUSSION:

When a Child Care Subsidy case is approved and the child is not immediately authorized to a provider, a FA150 is generated to the head of household informing them the child has been approved but there is no child care provider. The child displays on CHSTATUS (FM3P) with a code of H (Hold) for 30 days. After 30 days, if the child has not been authorized to a child care provider, FAMIS updates the Child Status field to W (Waiting List) and Wait List field to LP (Lack of Provider).

Effective June 5, 2016 when FAMIS updates the child's status from H to W/LP, a FA601 will be generated to the head of household reminding them the child is still on a waiting list because the child has not been authorized to a provider. The letter informs the head of household that if care is needed they should contact the FSD Call Center at 1-855-373-4636 with the child care provider information.
