- SUBJECT: CD206 Field added to Authorization Details in the FAMIS/FACES Interface

DISCUSSION:

On September 12, 2016 a new field will be added to Authorization Details screen in the FAMIS/FACES Interface. When completing an authorization to a registered child care provider, a new field will prompt the Children's Services Worker to verify the Child to Provider Relation form (CD206) has been completed and signed to verify relationship when the child and child care provider are related within the third degree. When entering a child care authorization and the relationship question is answered yes, identifying a child as related to the child care provider, the CD206 field will be a mandatory field with a "Y" for the answer. If the relationship question identifies a child as related and "N" is entered in the CD206 field an error message: **Authorization not Allowed until CD-206 has been signed** will display and the authorization will not be allowed.

The Child to Provider Relation form (CD-206) must be completed when it is indicated that the child(ren) and the Child Care Provider are related within the third degree. The CD-206 must be signed by the resource parent **and** the child care provider and kept with the official case record of the household. The resource parent and/or child care provider will be held accountable for completing the form correctly and will be required to provide verification of relationship (birth certificates, marriage licenses, etc.) upon request. Children related to the child care provider within the third degree are not considered when determining the number of children in care when a child care provider is not licensed with the Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS), Section for Child Care Regulation (SCCR). Relationships within the third degree include siblings (if not residing in the same home), nephews (not great), nieces (not great), grandchildren and great grandchildren.
